First Sunday in Advent

On Thursday our nation paused to celebrate Thanksgiving. In proclaiming the first nationwide Thanksgiving celebration in America, President George Washington proclaimed it “as a day of public thanksgiving and prayer, to be observed by acknowledging with grateful hearts the many and signal favours of Almighty God.” While the COVID-19 pandemic has made this year challenging for many, I hope and pray that each of us can see through the difficulties to recognize the many blessings that God has bestowed upon us and find the time to express our gratitude to Him for those blessings. Perhaps Thanksgiving is an opportunity for each of us to step back and identify the silver lining for us in this pandemic.

The celebration of Thanksgiving gives us pause to recognize that everything that happens in our lives, regardless of how good or bad they may seem, are gifts from God which are designed to help us grow in holiness. Even if we may not understand it in the present, God continues to shower us with immense blessings and I am confident that if we take the time to step back from the craziness of life to acknowledge those blessings they will become very clear for us. Thanksgiving, then is a reminder that “gratitude should always be our first response for all the blessings in our lives. Our second response should be to live a life worthy of the blessing we have received.” (Matthew Kelly).

Each and everyday I thank God for the blessing of being called to serve here at St. Theodore. In the 9 months I have been here I have been inspired by the deep faith and the strong commitment of our parishioners which has driven me to be the best priest I can for each and everyone of you. While I certainly don’t say it enough, let me take the opportunity to say thank you to each and everyone of you who has welcomed me with open arms and to each of you whose dedication continues to make St. Theodore the special place that it is.

This Sunday, marks the start of our four week journey of Advent as we prepare to welcome Christ anew at Christmas. In a year where everything has been different, I have been frequently reminded that Christ is still the same yesterday, today, and forever. The same light of Christ that pierced the cold dark winter night on that first Christmas, is still shining in the midst of the darkness of this world. This season of Advent provides us with the opportunity to prepare to receive that light anew this Christmas.

As we prepare for Christmas during the pandemic, I am mindful that if we have anywhere near the usual number of guests for Christmas Eve Masses we are going to struggle to find a way for everyone to stay socially distanced. I have begun this conversation with the parish council. Specifically I am planning to have Mass at both 3 and 5 on Christmas Eve to help spread out the usual busy for 4pm Mass crowd. I am also wondering how busy Midnight Mass might be, as I know many people would prefer it in Church, instead of the gym, but social distancing comes first. As always, if you have any ideas about how we can welcome the many visitors that join us and celebrate Christmas Masses in a safe way, I would appreciate it if you would share them with me.

In closing, let me say congratulations to five of our alumni from the class of 2018, Eric Belarde, Abby Hammond, Lexi Bross, Lacey Fowler, and Ben Eusterbrock, who were recently inducted into the National Honor Society at St. Dominic. This honor is a testament to your hard work and dedication as well as the many sacrifices of your parents. Likewise this honor reflects the hard work and dedication of our faculty and staff at St. Theodore School who work so hard to prepare our students to prepare for high school and beyond.
