# First Sunday in Advent

## From the Pastor

I hope you and your family had a blessed Thanksgiving. While Thanksgiving is certainly a prime opportunity to stop and give thanks, as Catholics we should stop every day to give thanks to God for the many blessings He has bestowed upon us. Might I encourage you to consider forming the habit of stopping every night for just a few moments before you go to bed to reflect back on your day and firstly count your blessings and give thanks to God for them before seeing those ways you have fallen short and asking God for forgiveness?

This weekend we begin our preparations for the coming of Christ at Christmas as we celebrate the first Sunday of Advent. The word Advent comes from two Latin words, *ad* and *venio*, literally meaning, coming towards. Advent is the time to open our hearts to allow Christ to come towards us. To help us open our hearts to Christ in preparation for Christmas, I am planning a four part homily series taking us back to the basics of our faith. This week, I will be preaching on why everyone should be Catholic. Next week, I preach on what the Mass is before preaching on why we should go to Mass every Sunday in the third Sunday of Advent, and then I will conclude the Advent homily series preaching on how to pray the Mass. The season of Advent is a perfect opportunity to welcome any of your friends or family who may have fallen away from the faith back to the Church and it is my prayer that this homily series will help each of us renew our commitment to the mini-Christmas of each Mass, when Heaven literally comes to earth in the Eucharist.

The search for our next principal is well underway. Over the past few weeks I have had the opportunity to meet with every faculty member who wanted to share their insights on St. Theodore School, I have hosted two listening sessions for parents, and I have had a meeting with our search committee. I have been deeply edified by these conversations and beyond being helpful in offering a picture of what we should look for in a principal, they have been validating that the path we have been on for the past several years is bearing much fruit. The job is officially posted and I am looking forward to receiving applications from qualified applicants.

I have been in discussions with the Archdiocese since early September, when we first realized that our kindergarten class will be substantially larger next year. After conversations with the parish council, finance council and members of the Archdiocese we began investigating the possibility of a portable classroom space. A couple of weeks ago, I met with Archbishop Rozanski, to discuss this plan in light of the two year building moratorium the Archdiocese has. In that meeting the Archbishop assured me our plans were not against the spirit of that moratorium and he would encourage us to proceed with it. Initial estimates for a portable classroom came in at well over \$100,000. Fortunately, Bross Construction was able to find a portable trailer which had been used by the Salem Public School System that can be purchased and brought up to code for about \$85,000. Shortly after my meeting with the Archbishop, Ted Bross and I met with the Archdiocese's building and maintenance office who agreed that our plans for that trailer were solid and said it was a no-brainer that we should proceed with this route. We are working with the fire marshal and the city of Flint Hill to have these plans approved and hope to have the portable classroom onsite soon so we can begin bringing it up to code. We will continue to engage in discussions with our teachers and parents about how best to utilize our space as we begin to open registration for next year in late January.

There are so many exciting things going on at St. Theodore and I am truly humbled to step back and watch all the great things God is doing here. As always, know of my prayers for each of you and please remember to keep me in your prayers.

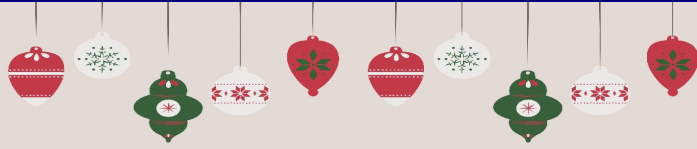

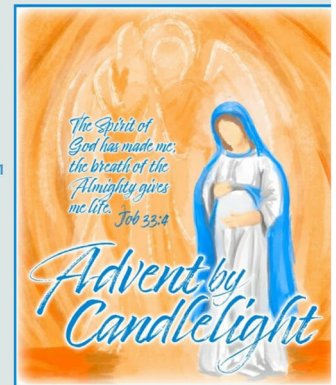
