# Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

## From Fr. Peter Fonseca

As we move, God willing, towards the end of the COVID-19 pandemic and life begins to return to normal, I want to take a moment to thank you for your patience and assistance over the past year and a half. This pandemic was unlike anything any of us had experienced and there certainly was no playbook for how to navigate it. There were many hours of phone calls with other pastors, meetings with parish staff and interested parishioners and even some sleepless nights throughout the pandemic as I tried to discern the best approach to attending Mass, setting policies for the school, hosting parish events, etc. While parishes enacted different policies that suited their various needs and everyone had their own opinions about how to best proceed, our parish stuck together and by God's grace we are making it out the other side stronger than before.

With the start of July, we are planning to continue following the plans we announced 6 weeks ago. Starting next Sunday all of our Masses will return to the church. I realize that everyone is returning to normal at their own pace and I want everyone to be as comfortable as possible attending Mass. If you think it is best to wear a mask, please do; if you are not comfortable using the holy water font, please don't; and if you are not ready to exchange the sign of peace, we all certainly understand.

When you return to the church, you will hear the new Kawai GX-30 grand piano, which was installed in the choir loft on Monday. The piano sounds amazing and will certainly add beauty to our Masses for generations to come.

Back on Tuesday, June 15<sup>th</sup>, the parish council met as they do every month. At that meeting we welcomed our newest members, Brad Burns, Jerry DiMercurio, Jamie Hammond, Teri Forbeck and John Matlick. Additionally, the council voted amongst themselves to elect officers for the coming year. You can find the minutes from the meeting on page 6 of this bulletin. The code of Canon Law, the law which governs the Church, states that "*In every parish of the diocese, a Pastoral Council shall be established ... The Pastoral Council assists in promoting pastoral action in the parish.*" (Canon 536 #1). The Parish Pastoral Council is a consultative body, that strives to discern the movement of the Holy Spirit among God's people in the parish. The council assists me in fostering the pastoral activity of the parish. Members of the council are parishioners who either have nominated themselves or have been nominated by another parishioner and are then chosen by the pastor, after consultation with the parish council. The council is composed of 12 members who serve a 3 year term and who elect amongst themselves a president, vice-president, and secretary.

While things slow down drastically at the parish over the summer, we are still here to serve you. Please mark your calendar for the parish picnic scheduled for July 18<sup>th</sup>. Additionally don't forget about our blood drive scheduled for July 6<sup>th</sup> and our the weekly Queen of Hearts tournament held every Thursday evening.

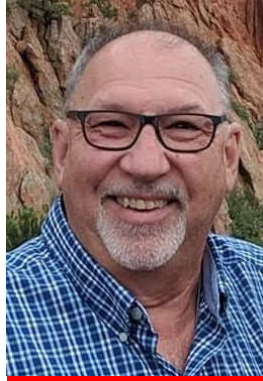
